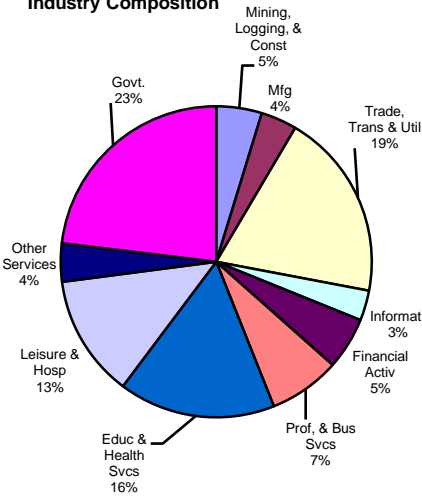
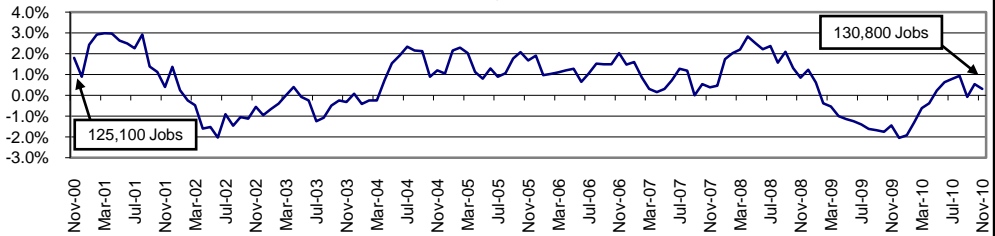


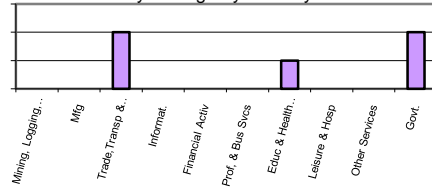
Industry Composition



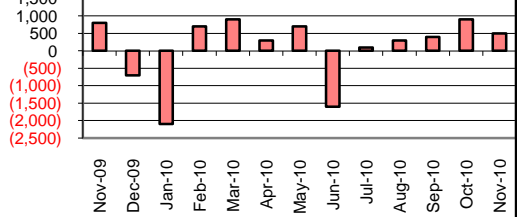
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

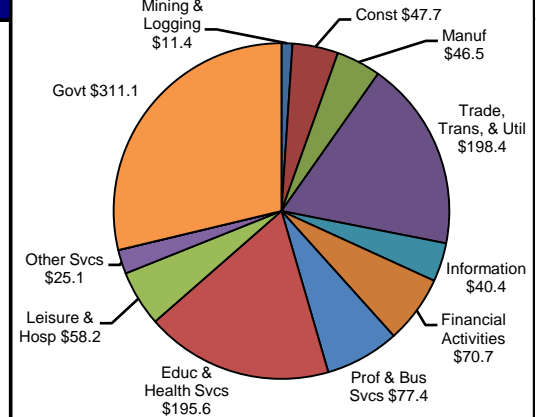

Comments for November 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Lubbock MSA added 500 jobs in November. Federal Government and State Government both added 100 positions over the month. Education and Health Services also gained 100 staff during the month. The annual growth rate for the Education and Health Services industry was 2.4 percent, and has gained 500 positions over the year. Retail Trade had a seasonal increase of 200 jobs in November. The annual growth rate for the Lubbock MSA was 0.3 percent.
