Frullo Named Champion of Free Enterprise

LUBBOCK- In recognition of his pro-business, pro-Texas voting record during the 82nd Legislative Session, State Representative John Frullo (R-Lubbock) was awarded the Texas Association of Business' "Champion of Free Enterprise" Award.

This award, the highest accolade awarded by the association, honors legislators who fought during the legislative session to promote a better business climate which will ensure that more, good-paying jobs come to and stay in Texas.

"As a small business owner myself, I know the impact overbearing rules and regulations can have on job creation," Frullo said.
