Dr. Richard “Chip” Peterson Seeks Lubbock County Libertarian Party 19th Congressional Nomination

Dr. Richard “Chip” Peterson has filed an application for the Lubbock County Libertarian Party’s nomination for Congressional District 19.

Peterson said he will focus on the federal budget and deficit during his campaign for congress saying “that the current fiscal problems of the U.S. have been aggravated by both the Republicans and Democrats. Both parties have spent excessively on fruitless foreign wars and pork barrel projects designed to further their reelection chances at the expense of the nations well being”

Peterson makes the third Lubbock area Libertarian to file for the November 2012 ballot along with Jerry Russell for Lubbock County Commissioner PCT 1 and Marion Smith for State Senate DST 28.
