Jerry Russell Files For Lubbock County Commissioner PCT 1

Jerry Russell of Lubbock County announced his intentions to seek the Lubbock County Libertarian Party's nomination for Lubbock County Commissioner PCT1 today by filing a application for nomination with the county chair.

Russell said if elected he would advocate for a low tax rate, frugal spending and better maintenance of county roads. Russell said he has been disappointed with both Republicans and Democrats on the commissioner's court saying the actual tax has doubled over the last 15 years from .16 to .32.
