

This is a copy of a poster mounted on the glass door windows at Municipal Court. I understand that there is another poster in the PD lobby. Also enclosed are several business-card sized handouts for Municipal Court/Police personnel to give to citizens in reference to red light camera payments.

The red light camera “Customer Service Center” does not have a local phone number published--only a toll-free 866 number. This service center for red light camera fines is NOT located at Municipal Court. I get the impression, and it looks like, that the company that the city bought the cameras from set up the service center for fine collection. Notice the “Red for a Reason” theme.

I am aware of at least one complaint by a citizen who was notified that his vehicle was red light camera cited, and he lives out of state and hasn't owned the vehicle in several years. His only recourse was to call the “Customer Service Center”

I have also been told (but with no authority) that the city will not pursue non-payment of red light camera tickers through a collection agency.

That sucking noise you hear is the Constitution going down the drain—at least in Lubbock, anyhow!

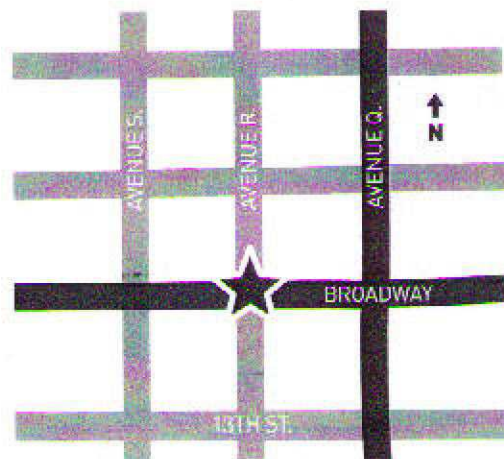
