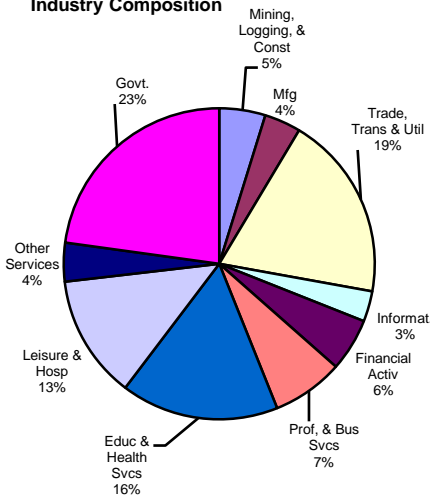
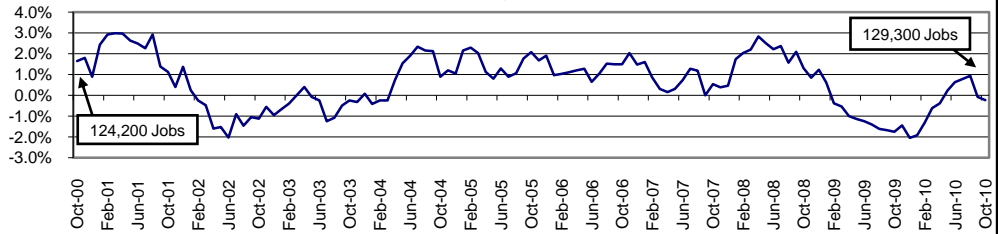


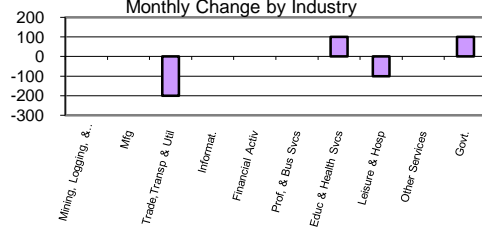
Industry Composition



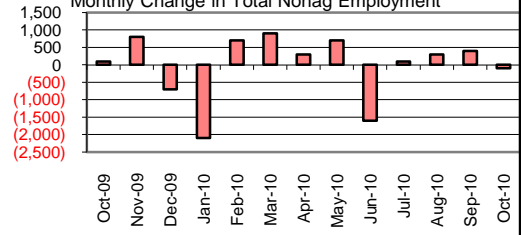
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

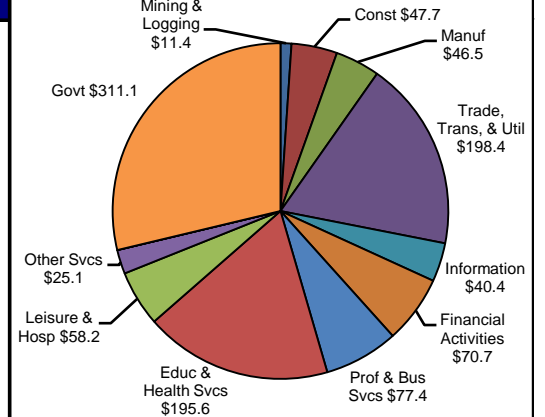

Comments for October 2010

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Lubbock MSA decreased by 100 staff in October. Education and Health Services added 100 positions over the month, for a 0.5 percent increase. The annual growth rate for the Education and Health Services industry was 2.4 percent, and has gained 500 positions over the year. Federal Government gained 100 jobs during the month, for a 7.7 percent increase. The annual growth rate remained steady in October.
