Marion Smith Files For Libertarian Spot For District 28 Senate

In a statement released today by retired businessman, Marion Smith, he announced his intention to seek the Lubbock County Libertarian Party's District 28 nomination for Texas State Senate.

Smith said he is primarily seeking the office to insure Republican incumbent, Robert Duncan, has an opponent in the general election. "It is fundamentally undemocratic for someone to be a shoe in on the November ballot as the only choice. District 28 voters deserve a choice" said Smith.

Smith categorized himself as a fiscal conservatives concerned about the State of Texas's \$5,700 per taxpayer in unfunded liabilities due the state's future retirees such as teachers and employees. Smith called the unfunded liabilities "a tax on future generations that is not being discussed by Robert Duncan and a threat to our financial stability." Smith sited his source for the \$5,700 per taxpayer as the non partisan Institute for Truth in Accounting (www.truthinaccounting.org).

Smith makes the second Lubbock area Libertarian to announce for office along with Jerry Russell who is seeking the County Commissioner PCT 1 nomination.
